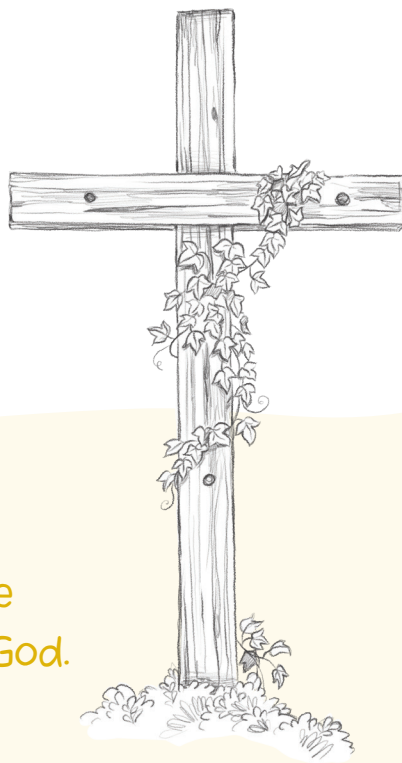

Jesus is the Word of God, and Jesus is God! Jesus was with God in the beginning when the universe was created! Jesus is the light of truth that shines in the evil darkness of this world.

Read **John 1:16-17**. What does Jesus offer to those who believe in Him?

When we believe that Jesus will save us from our sin, Jesus gives us grace—favor we don't deserve. This grace gives us a place in God's family as His children!

Before Jesus went to the cross to die for our sins, He told His disciples He would be going away. They didn't quite understand what Jesus had come to do. In John 14, Jesus tells them that although He is leaving them for now, He will not leave them forever. Jesus was going to prepare a home for them after they lived on this earth. Then the disciples would get to be with Jesus forever!

Thomas was fearful that Jesus would leave and he would never see Him again. Thomas also didn't understand why Jesus had to go away or where He was going.
